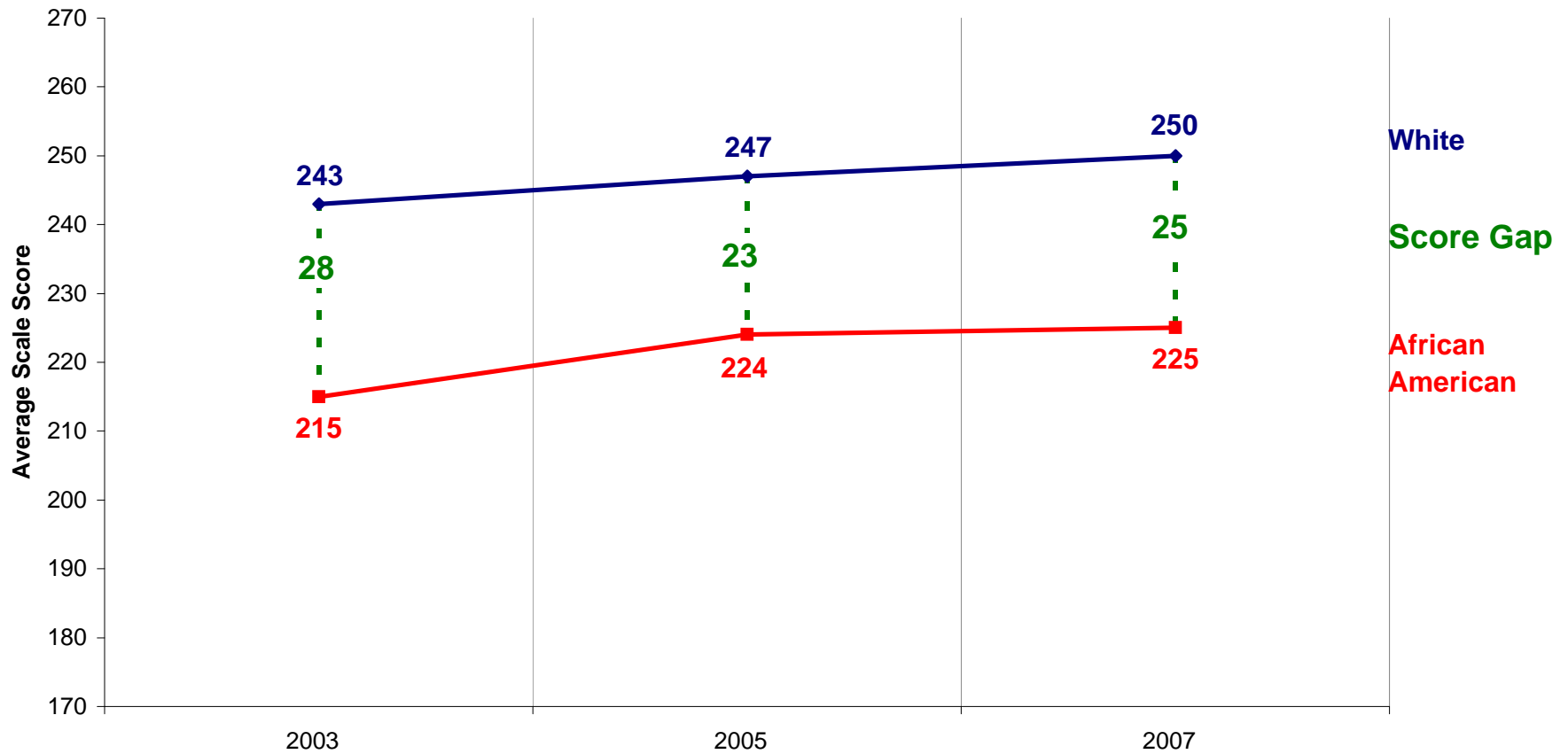

Average Mathematics scale scores and score gaps for White - African American students, Grade 4: 2003-2007



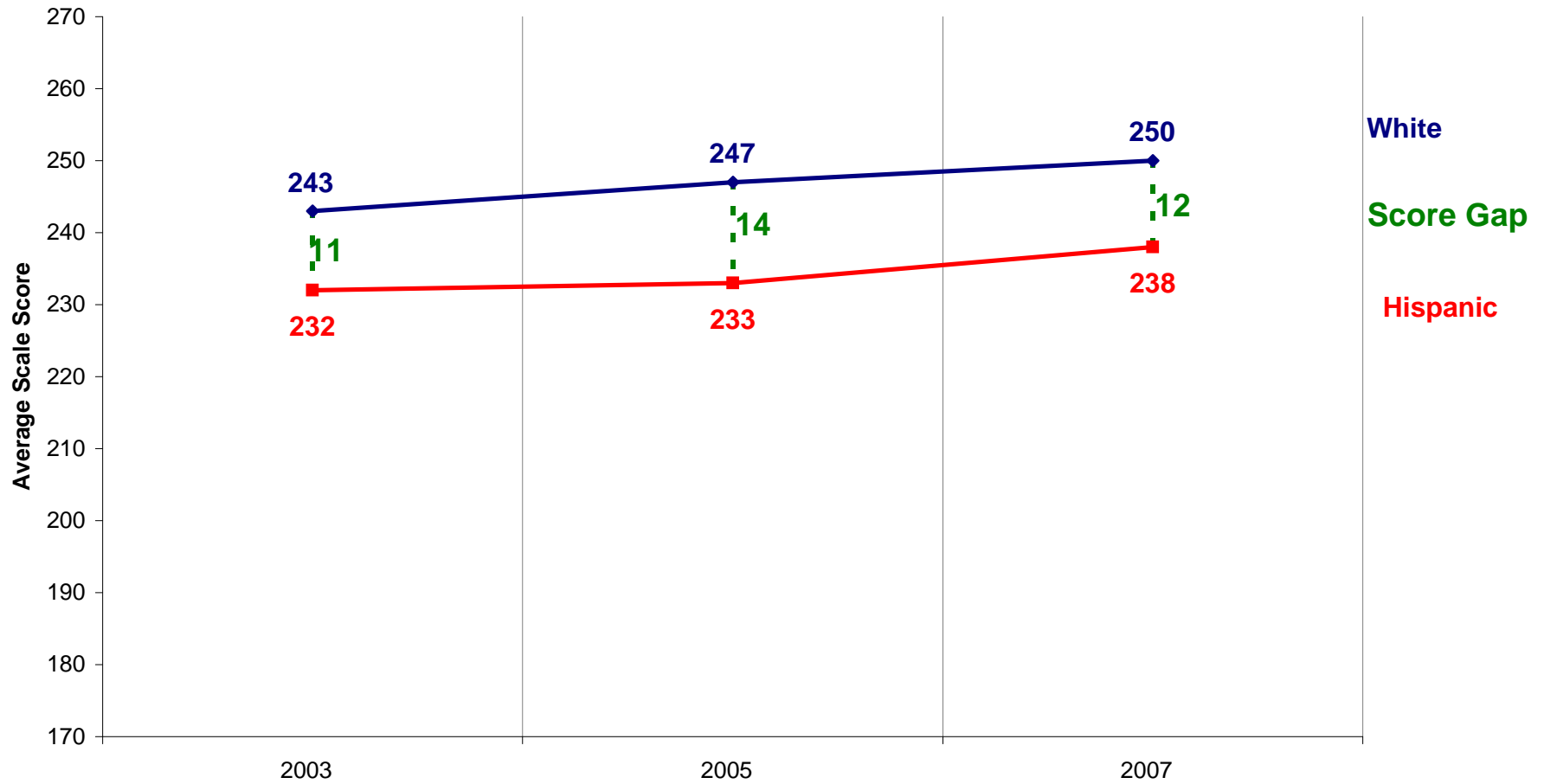
