BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 228.041 (13), Florida Statutes, previously defined the “school day” and provided the State Board of Education with authority to adopt rules authorizing the decrease in the minimum length of the school day for double-session schools, experimental schools, or schools operating under emergency conditions. However, when the education statutes were rewritten in 2002, this authority was not provided to the State Board of Education. As the State Board of Education is limited to retaining rules limited to the specific rulemaking authority this rule is recommended for repeal.
