1001.42(22)(e), Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1001.42(22), Florida Statutes, requires districts to report to the State Board of Education by September 1 of each year on findings and potential solutions to paperwork issues in their district.

The statute further requires that the State Board of Education prepare a report of statewide findings and potential solutions to the Governor, President of the Senate, and Speaker of the House of Representatives by October 1 of each year.
