Go to http://reporting.collegeboard.com/rms/Welcome.do. Enter your user name and password under Sign In to View Reports. First-time visitors are asked to create an educational professional account and enter their AP Potential access code. Access codes are mailed to principals in December and also included on the PSAT/NMSQT Roster of Scores and Plans. District superintendents receive access codes, via mail, in December.
