Appendix N

Perkins IV indicators of performance include measures for non-traditional student participation and completion. The Act defines non-traditional occupations as *occupations or fields of work, including careers in computer science, technology, and other current and emerging high skill occupations, for which individuals from one gender comprise less than 25% of the individuals employed in each such occupation or field of work* [Perkins IV, Section 3, (20)].

The following secondary and postsecondary non-traditional identification list was created using the 2006-07 program enrollments to determine the non-traditional status for each of the programs available in the state. Florida has determined that the best predictor of non-traditional CTE programs is past enrollment data. This list will be reviewed and updated every two years based on enrollments from the previous year.
